On Thursday 17th September 2009, 11 Year 8 students took part in the Corus Kids of Steel Triathlon held at Newham Leisure Centre.

The event hosted by Triathlon England in association with Corus Steel is aimed at introducing young people aged between 8 and 13 to the sport of triathlon in a safe fun environment so that the participants may want to continue their interest in the future.

On the day, the students were required to complete a 50 metre swim, followed by a 1.2km bike ride and finishing with a 500 metre run. The focus was on participation rather than on competition and the students were very pleased to receive a goodie bag with a T-shirt, swim cap, drink and medal for completing the event.

The well organised day was all about giving triathlon a go which all of the 11 students certainly did! They thoroughly enjoyed the experience.
